As you know the Umatilla County Critical Groundwater Task Force (Task Force) was formed by the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners in 2004 with a mission to "identify and implement technically and economically feasible measures to enhance and protect groundwater quantity and quality, as an essential natural resource necessary to assure continued economic development in Umatilla County, especially in designated Critical Groundwater Areas." A draft of the 2050 Plan is currently under a formal public review process funded by the Task Force.

In addition to the formal review of the 2050 Plan, the State of Oregon has earmarked \$750,000 to study storing water via aquifer recharge to replace existing groundwater rights in the four designated Critical Groundwater Areas of Umatilla County.

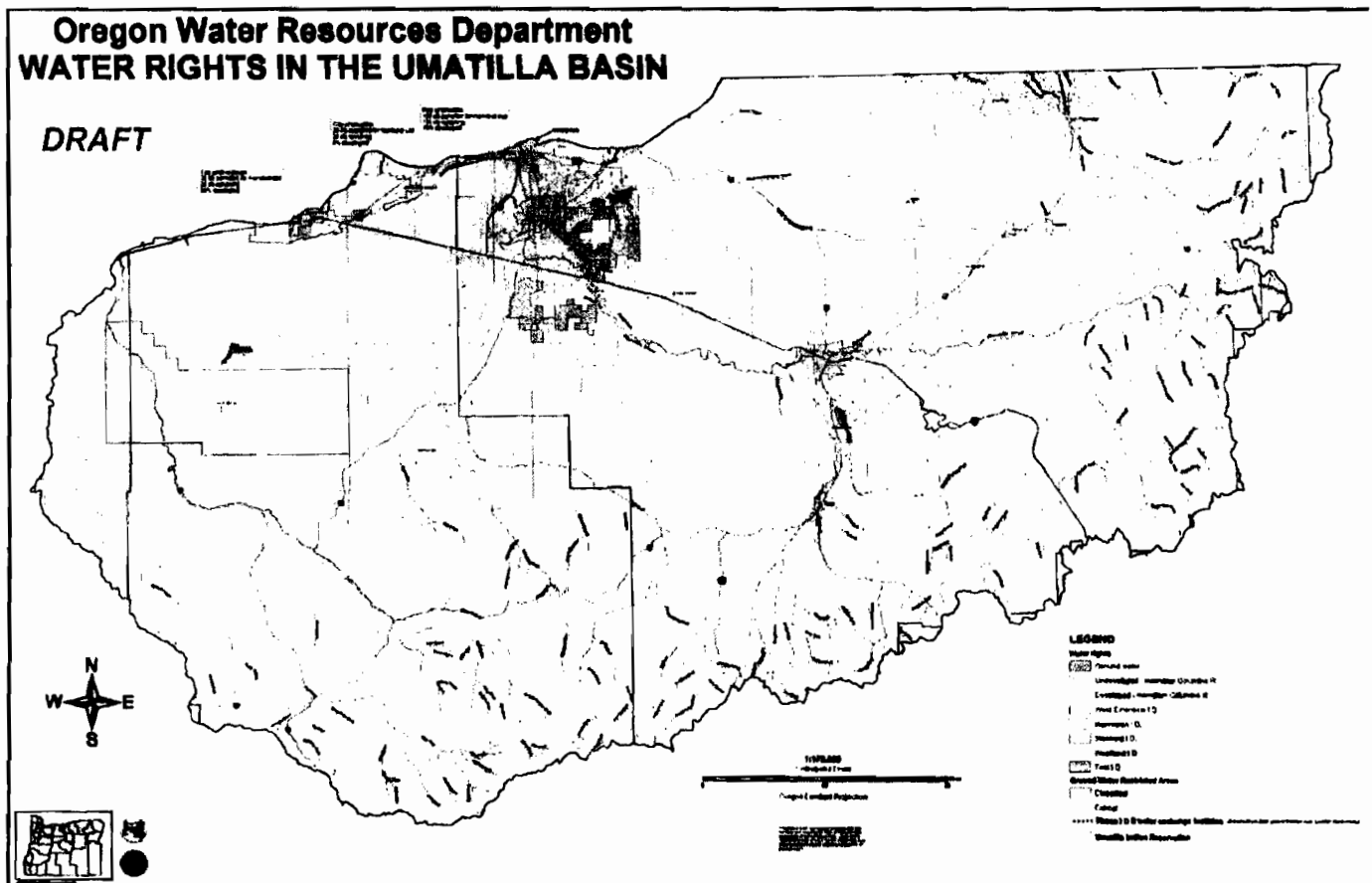
**(E) Description of Stakeholders**

Please see Attachment A for an overview of all of the stakeholders involved in the 2050 Plan process. The intent of the county is to continue to keep these stakeholders involved as the planning process transitions into an attempt to begin implementation.

**(F) Region-Wide Water Benefits**

This planning and coordination effort will build off of the opportunities provided by SB 1069 to address short-term and long-term water supply needs in the basin. This project has the potential to replenish water supply lost to water users in this region over the last several decades. Additionally, this project has the potential to initiate the recovery of basalt groundwater aquifers, improve groundwater quality, and improve surface water quality and quantity in the lower 18 miles of the Umatilla River.

The project boundaries will be the Umatilla River Watershed which includes the Lower Umatilla Basin Groundwater Management Area and four State of Oregon designated Critical Groundwater Areas. The intent is to include the CTUIR, Morrow County OWRD and ODEQ in the process. A map showing the geographic limitations of the project is provided below.



## **(G) Additional Benefits of the Project**

- 1) Continuing Consensus Based Planning
  - This project will continue a consensus based process that includes irrigation districts, individual irrigators, private water system owners, the CTUIR, Port of Umatilla, Task Force and Morrow and Umatilla County Governments.
  
- 2) Promoting Multiple Use/Conjunctive Management of Water Resources
  - We believe that this project, in conjunction with SB 1069 funding will identify ways to recover alluvial and basalt aquifers in the Umatilla Basin, provide water security to irrigation and non-irrigation water users, improve groundwater quality and improve Umatilla River flows during critical times for anadromous fish species.
  - We believe this project can be example for the state to prove that water supplies can be developed without adverse impacts to listed Columbia River fish species.
  
- 3) Biggest Bang for the Buck
  - With conservative estimates of over \$150 million in annual economic benefits to the region, we believe this project is the biggest “bang for the buck” in the Umatilla Basin
  - This project is also a financially feasible way to provide the rest of the state with management examples and technology that is possible statewide (e.g. aquifer recharge and conjunctive management).
